GRANT AWARDED!

The Center was recently awarded a one-



year, \$350,000 grant from Episcopal Health Foundation that began June 1, 2021. These funds will allow the Center to hire a strategic consultant to help align our organization's integration as a community mental health center, along with a CCBHC and FQHC. There are also funds for a Children's Substance Use counselor and an additional caseworker for care coordination as these are strategic priorities of the Center.
