Program Spotlight Texas Veteran Commission General Assistance Grant (TVC GA)



The TVC GA grant provides homeless prevention for veterans (with an honorable/other than honorable discharge), surviving spouses, and dependents. The grant provides rental assistance along with utility assistance including cell phone and internet for those facing eviction and utility disconnections. Before assistance is granted, an intake is completed with the veteran to collect all necessary documents and verify guidelines are met for this grant. *For more information, contact the East*

Parents as Teachers (PAT) is a no-cost, voluntary program available to Gregg, Smith, and some Harrison County families that are pregnant and/or have children that are not enrolled in full-day school. PAT is an early childhood parent education and family support program designed to enhance child development and school achievement. Services include personal visits twice each month, screenings for children, and resources for families. Children enrolled in the Parents as Teachers (PAT) program at age 3 show higher skill levels and school readiness.
