
Welcome to 2022!

Texas Balance of State Continuum of Care (TX BoS CoC)

What? | The PIT Count aims to provide a **snapshot** of the individuals and families experiencing homelessness in a geographical area, over the course of one night.

When? | **Thursday: January 27th, 2022**

Who? | Individuals and families residing in:
Unsheltered Locations: Cars, parks, streets/sidewalks, etc.
Sheltered Locations: Emergency Shelter, Transitional Housing

Why? | **Awareness:** Advocate to local governments
Extent: Determine the number of people experiencing homelessness
Funding: Data can be used to secure grant funding
Engagement: Community involvement in ending homelessness


