There are limited spots available and registration will close on 8/25/22.

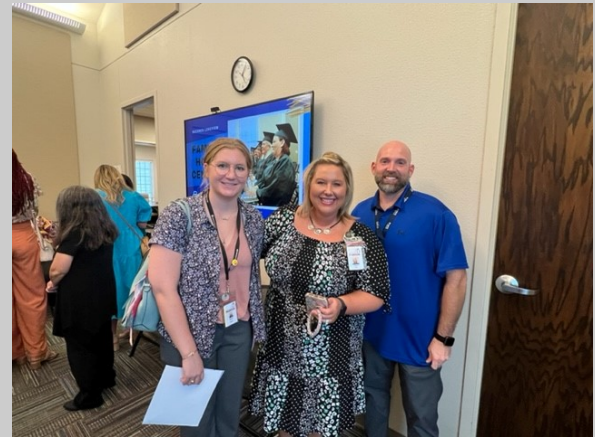
